Tariff Basic knowledge



## US Tariff(s )

are a tax or duty levied on imports

are administered at customs clearance by Customs Border Patrol (CBP) at the port of entry (airport, border, seaport, etc.)

are paid by the importer of record and are typically assessed based on the import value (commercial invoice) of shipment

amounts are determined by country of origin and Harmonized System (HS) code of commodity being imported

can, and often are, in addition to other existing tariffs and duties



STATUS*	COUNTRY	DESCRIPTION
In effect FEB 4	China	10% on all imports
In effect MAR 4	Mexico	25% on all imports
In effect MAR 4	Canada	25% on most imports, lower rate for energy
In effect MAR 4	China	Additional 10% on all imports
Partially Suspended Mar 6	Canada  Mexico	Reprieve for goods that fall under the USMCA trade pact
In effect Mar 12	<b>G</b> lobal	25% on aluminum and steel
Planned April 2	Global	Unspecified tariff on all agricultural products
Planned April 2	<b>G</b> lobal	Unspecified tariff on all foreign cars

## Understanding Impact

- Country of origin of your high value supply chain (raw materials and equipment).
  - Tier 1 and tier 2 supply base.
- HS codes for your high value imports to understand cumulative effect of tariffs/duties
  - Link to research HS codes <a href="https://www.trade.gov/customs-info-database-user-guide">https://www.trade.gov/customs-info-database-user-guide</a>
- Record the effect of supplier pass-through increases identified as tariff impact for future negotiation
  - Many of current proposed tariffs are expected to be temporary in nature
- Expect lead times to increase given the capacity of CBP administration to process imports



Alternatives and Offsets




#### Alternatives to Avoid or Offset

- Pricing strategies to offset
  - Portfolio price adjustment, spread the impact
  - Specific impacted product price adjustments
- Use of a Free Trade Zone (FTZ) through a partner/third party (logistics or customs broker). Applies to goods imported for reexport.
- Realign your supply base
  - Assess new suppliers based on location and landed cost
  - Identify alternate sourcing locations with existing suppliers
- Evaluate exclusions. USTR has processed many exclusions for various products that you may be able apply.



#### Free Trade Zones Covering McHenry County


